

Peppers at flora gardens

Sweet	<i>Hot</i>
<p>Aruba 65 days Large cubanelle type. Beautiful 8-9" slightly curved peppers grow on strong plants. Medium - green fruits turn bright red when mature. Good flavour and sweetness. Excellent for grilling. Matures earlier than other varieties in the same class. Improved disease resistance .</p> <p>Cubanelle 68 days. Large, smooth tapered peppers. Fruit are lime green 6 in/15 cm long, 2 in./5 cm wide at the shoulder, slightly tapered to fairly blunt ends.</p> <p>Keystone (Sweet Green) 79 days. Green ripening to red. Large, blocky, pendant fruit (3½ x 4 in.). Mosaic resistant. Heavy foliage reduces susceptibility to sunscald. Thick stems hold up under heavy fruit load.</p> <p>Giant Szegedi (Yellow Stuffer) 70 days. Large top shaped, pendant, fruit -4 1/4 in. x 2 3/4 in./10.5 cm x 6.8 cm.</p> <p>Sweet Banana 75 days. A huge crop of peppers, often 30 on a plant. The fruit are 1 ½ inches in diameter and 6in long, tapered.</p> <p>Redstart 65 days. Fantastic yields and taste. Dark green, 3 3/4 inch fruit ripen to 3--4 lobed red bells by early Sept.</p> <p>Super Shepherd 68 days. Popular Italian sweet pepper. Dark red 7 1/2in fruit are early, tapered, thick flesh and a distinct sweet juicy flavour. Nice for frying.</p> <p>Nikita NEW! 65-70 days. Golden with red-orange highlights. bold, bright flavor and crispness. Holds its crispness and shape when cooked, even under high heat. Nicely-branched plants produce early and prolifically.</p>	<p>Bogyiszlói (Medium Yellow) 70 days. Medium hot Bell shaped, very firm fruit, 3 ½ in by 2 in.</p> <p>Ring of fire (Hot) 60 days. An extra early, short, smooth pencil thin Cayenne type. Fruit are very hot. 4 in. long.</p> <p>Hungarian Wax (Yellow Hot Banana) 60 days. Yellow fruit average 6in. in length, very uniform and slightly tapered. Ripens green--yellow--red.</p> <p>Jalapeno (La Bombe) NEW! 56 days. Strong, upright plants have a sturdy main stem plus a dense canopy to prevent sunscald. Large, dark green fruit has thick walls. Great fresh. High-quality jalapeños have good flavour with medium heat. Resists Potato Virus Y. Suited to gardens and planters.</p> <p>Jalapeno Gigante NEW! 80 days. The largest jalapeño, these peppers measure as much as 5 in. (13 cm) long! Grows easily in patio containers.</p> <p>Habanero (Very hot!): Small silver dollar sized acorn-shaped fruit. Turn green/gold/pale orange/red.</p> <p>Alma Paprika 80 days. An excellent heirloom from Hungary. The round peppers ripen from cream to orange to red and are excellent for drying and grinding into paprika. They are also excellent for eating fresh. Medium hot.</p>
